- Societal problems have a land footprint.



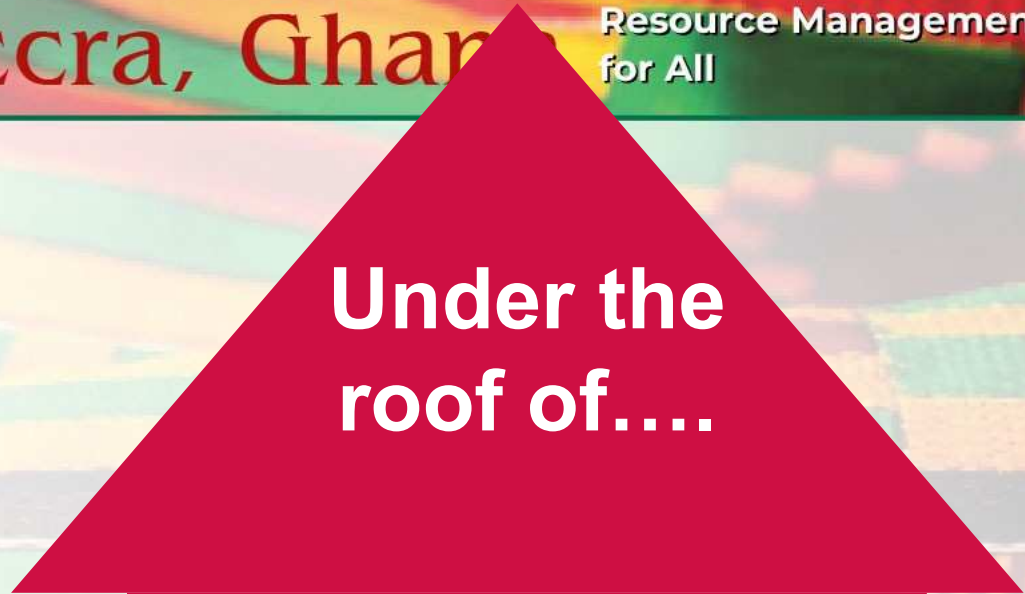
